

Jereh Signs Another New EPC Contract in Pakistan

Yantai/Feb. 14, 2016/ Jereh Group announced it was awarded an EPC contract from Fauji Foundation, one of the largest energy conglomerates in Pakistan covering power generation, natural gas, oil terminal operations and health care, for feed gas treatment of a power plant.
